Thursday

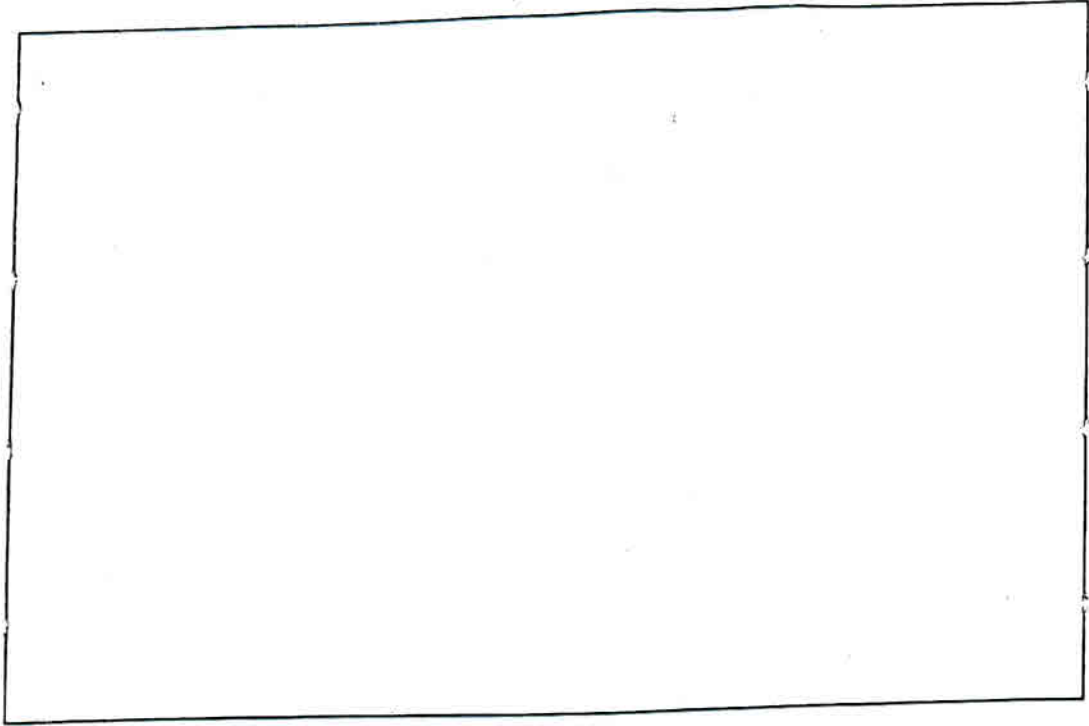
- Continue to fill in January calendar dates on a daily basis. In your HWN write the numeral show the amount and write the word for the corresponding date on the calendar
